

International Call for Visiting Scholars PENO / PRINT 2023

The **Ocean Engineering Program (PENO) of COPPE / UFRJ** invites **5 (five) scholars** from academic and research institutions for short visits of 15 days (4) or 30 days (1), during the calendar year 2023, for participating in the Ocean Engineering Program (both thematic areas: Coastal & Oceanographical Engineering, and Naval & Ocean Engineering), according to three research lines: (1) Changes in wave climate; (2) Computer sciences and engineering. (3) Intelligent cities.

Airfare, health insurance, displacement allowance, and a scholarship of R\$ 9,000 (nine thousand reais) for 15 days will be paid by CAPES directly to the beneficiary, in the foreign account bank designated by the beneficiary. No payment in Brazilian reais is possible.
